#### Lead Facts: Did You Know

EPA states "Lead is a highly toxic metal that was used for many years in products found in and around our homes. Lead health effects range from behavioral problems and learning disabilities to seizures and death. Children 6 years old and under are most at risk because their bodies are growing guickly."

- <u>EPA Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RRP)</u> requires companies performing renovations, repairs and painting that disturb pre 1978 paint must be EPA certified and follow lead safe work practices.
- ♦ <u>EPA Violation Enforcement Actions</u> have been issued to landlords, real estate companies, management companies and contractors involving large monetary fines.
- <u>Lead dust is a hazard in homes</u> created from opening/closing windows and disturbance of painted surfaces by everyday living.
- Lead pipes and solder can <u>leach lead into drinking water</u> from corrosion especially in pre 1986 plumbing.
- Many consumer products contain lead especially those imported.
- ♦ Real Estate Notification & Disclosure Rule requires realtors and sellers to provide an EPA approved lead information pamphlet, disclose all lead paint information and provide a 10 day testing period as part of the contractual agreement.
- <u>Property managers and landlords</u> are required under Federal law to disclose information regarding lead evaluation, hazards, reports and records regarding lead.

All pre- 1978 homes should be tested for lead paint especially if children are present.

# Soil Gas Vapor Intrusion: Emerging Indoor Air Quality Concern

Vapor intrusion is the migration of volatile chemicals from groundwater and subsurface soil emitting gases that become trapped in structures. Volatile organic compounds (VOC'S) sources include leaking gasoline storage tanks, paints, lacquers, paint strippers, cleaning supplies, pesticides, glues, adhesives, photographic solutions and dry cleaning chemicals that have migrated into the water or soil. Concentrations of many chemicals off-gassing can be up to ten times higher indoors than outdoors and have short and long-term adverse health effects. WES performs comprehensive VOC, chemical and combustion gas testing.

### Asbestos Testing

Asbestos is a naturally occurring mineral used in many building materials prior to 1981. When disturbed, microscopic fibers are released with the potential to become lodged in the lungs causing long-term health effects and lung cancer. State law requires that pre-1981 building materials are tested prior to disturbance.

### Radon Testing

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas emanating from certain types of bedrock that becomes trapped in structures and can only be detected by radon testing. Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer. Radon is fairly inexpensive to test and elevated radon levels can be easily mitigated. WES performs short-term radon air testing for real estate transactions and long-term radon testing for residential and commercial buildings in addition to water testing following EPA guidelines.
